August 2015

One of the benefits of attending the annual J.E.M.S. conference at Mt. Hermon is the opportunity to sit under some good teaching from the various guest speakers. This year I was especially inspired by Ken Shigematsu; Sr. Pastor of Tenth Church in Vancouver, BC, one of the largest and most diverse city – center churches in Canada.

Pastor Ken covered a lot of the material in his book "God In My Everything", which speaks to the need of all believers to establish a type of rhythm of spiritual practices in life, intended to "help us experience the transforming presence of Christ in everything and extend His grace to the world."

Of particular interest to me are the rhythms of practicing Sabbath, and daily meditation. The biblical idea of Sabbath speaks to a full day of rest from our normal work routine. I have been negligent in making time for Sabbath; so my goal is to now set aside one day per week to simply rest – easier said than done. Moreover, I am striving to be more consistent in my times of daily meditation, as I seek to quiet myself before God. Ken's book is a wealth of helpful and encouraging insight. I would encourage you to pick up a copy for yourself – you will find it to be a very good investment.


If you can also help sell tickets, contact either Julee or Karen.
