Pastor's Message

January 2017

Author, innovation consultant, and speaker Stephen Shapiro, with the help of Opinion Corporation of Princeton, New Jersey, offers a number of interesting statistics concerning New Year's resolutions.

For instance, Shapiro found that:

* The less happy you are, the more likely you are to set New Year's resolutions (this is especially true for those who set money-related resolutions: forty-one percent are not happy; thirty-four percent are moderately happy; twenty-five percent are happy).

He then concludes with this;

There is actually no correlation between happiness and resolution setting/success (people who achieve their resolutions every year are no happier than those who do not set resolutions or who are unsuccessful in achieving them).

As I sat preparing next Sunday's New Year's Day sermon, I thought about that startling fact; setting resolutions really does not bring a deep sense of joy or fulfillment. In fact, I am convinced that true happiness can only be found through an act performed by someone outside of us; that is God's Holy Spirit. The Apostle Peter tells us that God, "In his great mercy has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead". This is a life changing truth. So instead of counting on a New Year's Resolution to bring fulfillment, I need only stop and consider that all I need for joy and hope in this life was already accomplished for me when God, thru my faith in Jesus, adopted me into His royal, eternal family.
