Pastor's Message July 2017

I am almost always convicted on some level by every sermon I preach: In particular when the message comes from one of the gospels. When I say "convicted" I am referring to the realization that I have fallen short in fulfilling God's commands for obedience, which then requires me to do some soul searching and often confession of sin. This is actually a healthy process, because I don't wallow in guilt or beat myself up over my shortcomings. I simply bring my sin before God, accept His forgiveness and then ask Him for the strength to live a more God honoring life.

I tell you this because recently that sense of conviction was particularly strong. In fact I am still wrestling with the passage I preached on from Romans 12 last week. In this great chapter, the Apostle Paul speaks of the importance of showing godly love not only toward one another, but toward the unlovable as well: not just feeling it, but demonstrating it. There are strong echoes here of Jesus' command to love our enemies.

I have no problem loving friends and family; it is when I'm asked to extend that action to those outside my circle that I hesitate. I know that I do not love like I should, but I want to. I also realize that none of us are able to demonstrate true godly love toward those we dislike apart from the considerable help of His Holy Spirit. My hope and prayer is that God will work within our community, transforming us into disciples of Jesus who are known for their love toward all people.
